**WHO SHOULD ATTEND:** **All sworn law enforcement personnel (full or part time)**

This is a 40-hour Basic SWAT course covering every area of tactics for a basic operator. This will be an intense course that will be physically and mentally demanding. Some of the tactical areas that will be covered are an overview of SWAT, physical fitness for the SWAT operator, tactical dynamic and static room clearing, SCAT with and without weapons, tactical firearms (handgun, rifles, submachine gun, shotgun), ballistic shields, down man rescue, entry drills, vehicle takedowns, legal issue for the SWAT operator and several more intense blocks of instruction.
